IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ALL REGISTRANTS

The Softball Board wants to provide every member of the Club with the opportunity to participate in a program or league that best fits their personal needs and preferences. However, registrations fluctuate season-to-season, so until we see the final numbers, the following will be offered at a minimum:

- Men's A-League and B-League (competitive)
- Ladies League (competitive)
- Men's A and B Sub-Pools; Ladies League Sub-Pool
- Instructional Program (CORT)

With enough registration and interest, the Board would like to offer the following additional options:

- Recreational: non-structured, scrimmage games based on skill levels
- Additional league splits by skill level IF enough registrations

Until we see our final registration numbers, we cannot make the decisions regarding which specific leagues and programs we will be able to provide. We can assure everyone that wants to play that there will be a place for them.

Please let us know your preferences on this registration form and we'll build the Fall season accordingly.

ALL NEW PLAYERS <u>MUST ATTEND</u> at least one New Player Evaluation session to play. Former players that did not play in Spring 2025 and/or Fall 2024, or those returning from a significant health issue or surgery, <u>MAY BE REQUIRED TO ATTEND</u> a New Player Evaluation session as well, as determined by the league leadership. SCP SOFTBALL ASSOCIATION CODE OF ETHICS CONDUCT / SPORTSMANSHIP STANDARDS

Objective:

To ensure that while striving for the best in competition, the Membership (players, managers, umpires, and other support people) adhere to good sportsman intentions and behavior.

Expectations:

- 1. Players, managers & umpires will play the game fairly and will treat each other with respect.
- 2. Cheating or manipulation of the rules of any sort will not be tolerated.
- 3. Players will compete with full effort and will do all they can to ensure the safety of their teammates, as well as their opponents.
- 3. Players are expected to play hard, but remember this is a game, and that the games are played in front of spectators of all ages. Use of inappropriate language MUST be controlled. Also, verbal abuse of other players, managers, and umpires will not be tolerated of Members, whether on the field as players or off the field as spectators.

Actions:

The SCP Softball Protest & Conduct Committee (PCC) is charged with investigating and understanding any complaints filed, as stated below, concerning bad sportsmanship observed. A Member of the Board will attend all games played, either as a player, umpire, or interested spectator.

Process:

- 1. Any player, manager, umpire, or spectator may file a complaint to the Board, league coordinator, the head umpire at a game, any team manager, or any member of the PCC by supplying the details of the event in writing.
- 2. The PCC will assess the event as quickly as possible (knowing that time is of the essence in dealing with these types of matters) and render a written recommendation to the Board.

Behavior and Discipline:

Proper behavior and decorum are expected from all Members and non-member fans. Those who are abusive, project an undesirable or inappropriate image, use profanity, direct outbursts of anger towards players, umpires or spectators, throw and/or misuse equipment, engage in rough play that could unnecessarily injure an opponent, initiate a one-on-one confrontation of a threatening nature, either before, during or after a game or who unnecessarily and blatantly create turmoil, disruption, and dissention among Club Member or other clubs or the Association in general may have their membership temporarily suspended or terminated by the club. Non-members will be asked to either cease their inappropriate behavior or to leave Veterans Field.

The following are recommended steps for club Member disciplinary action depending on the severity of the infraction:

A. First Offense: minimum written warning from Club, suspension

B. Second offense: short term suspension by the Club (minimum one season)C. Third offense: longer term suspension by the Club (two seasons or more)

D. Fourth offense: permanent termination from the Club
